Convicted Felon Charged in West Side Shooting



Offender: **Kenneth Baines, 25 (Mug shot unavailable)**
3500 block of West Lexington
Chicago, IL

Charges: One felony count of AGG BATTERY/FIREARM
One felony count of UUW-WEAPON-FELON, POSSESS/USE FIREARM
One felony count of ATTEMPT ROBBERY-ARMED W/FIREARM
One felony count of AGG DISCHARGE FIREARM

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Ave. – March 30, 2018 (offender will not appear)

Narrative: Kenneth Baines was arrested by 11th District officers on March 28, 2018, on the 200 block of North Kenneth at approximately 8:30 p.m. Baines was identified as the offender who shot a 57 year old male victim after he entered a church on the 4400 block of West Maypole and announced a robbery. The victim was able to return fire, striking the offender, before the offender fled the scene. No further information is available at this time.
