### **Preliminary Statement on Police Involved Shooting In the 4700 block of West Fulton**

CHICAGO – On Tuesday July 3rd, 2018 at approximately 7:59 p.m., 11th District Tactical Officers were responding to a person with a gun call in the 4700 block of West Fulton St. when they were confronted by an armed offender. Officers fired shots at the offender striking him. The offender was transported to Stroger Hospital where he was later pronounced. A weapon was recovered at the scene.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department.

The Officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a period of 30 days.
