Juvenile Charged in Vehicular Hijackings



Offender: Male Juvenile, 14

Charges: Two Felony Counts of Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking-Weapon

Court: Juvenile Court – 1100 S. Hamilton Ave. – June 1, 2019

Narrative: A 14-year-old male juvenile was placed into custody on May 30, 2019 at approximately 9:39 p.m. in the 2100 block of W. Adams, after a short foot pursuit. The juvenile offender was identified as the individual who approached a 30-year-old female and took the victim's 2018 SUV along with her purse at gunpoint. The incident occurred on May 21, 2019 at approximately 8:07 a.m. in the parking lot of a High School. The victim was not injured during the incident. Through the course of the investigation, the juvenile was also identified as the offender in an armed robbery that occurred on May 18, 2019 at approximately 12:55 p.m. in the 0 -100 block of N. Paulina. No further details are available at this time.
