West Side Man Charged with Attempted Murder of Police Officers



Offender: Milo Brown, 30
1100 Block of North Lawler
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Three Felony Counts of Attempt-Murder-First Degree
One Felony Count of Aggr Discharge Firearm-Occupied Vehicle
One Felony Count of UUW-Weapon-Felon, Possess/Use Firearm
One Felony Count-IVC-Agg Fleeing/2+Con Devices

Court: Central Bond Court, 26th & California – September 8th, 2019

Narrative: Brown was placed into custody on September 6th, 2019 at approximately 6:38 p.m. in the 200 Block of S. Karlov after he was observed exiting a stolen vehicle in the 3800 Block of W. Adams and firing multiple rounds at citizens on the street before turning and firing on officers. Officers were not struck but a 24-year-old man suffered two gunshot wounds to the abdomen. He is currently in serious condition at Stroger. Immediately after the shooting, Brown attempted to flee in the stolen vehicle but lost control of it and then fled on foot but was placed into custody moments later by responding officers. No further information is available at this time.
