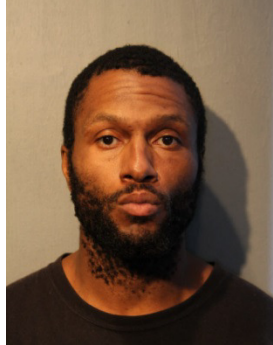

Man Charged with Multiple Crimes



Offender: Adam Bramwell, 32
6200 Block of S. Michigan Ave.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) Felony Count – Attempt First Degree Murder
One (1) Felony Count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) Felony Count – Armed Robbery
One (1) Felony Count – Aggravated Battery/Strangle
One (1) Felony Count – Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking – Weapon
One (1) Felony Count – Attempt Vehicular Hijacking
One (1) Felony Count – Receive/Possess/Sell Stolen Vehicle
Two (2) Felony Counts – Attempt Kidnapping – Force/Threat of Force
Two (2) Felony Counts – Arson
One (1) Misdemeanor Count – Criminal Trespass to Real Property
Two (2) Counts – Issuance of Warrant

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – September 20, 2019

Narrative: Adam Bramwell was extradited from Texas on an active arrest warrant and transferred to Chicago Police custody on September 17, 2019. Bramwell was wanted in connection to an aggravated vehicular hijacking and an aggravated battery that occurred on July 13, 2019 in the Lincoln Park neighborhood. Bramwell has also been charged with the attempted murder of a woman that occurred in the 2300 block of N. Halsted on July 18, 2019. Bramwell was charged accordingly.
