### **Offender Charged with Reckless Discharge of a Firearm and Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon**



**Offender:** Demontre Enos, 24  
3500 block of West Lexington Street  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) Felony Count – Reckless Discharge of a Firearm – Endanger  
One (1) Felony Count – Unlawful Use of a Weapon – Felon, Possess/Use Firearm

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave – April 12, 2020

**Narrative:** A ShotSpotter notification of "shots fired" near Wilcox and Springfield at approximately 6:58 PM led 11th District Strategic Decision Support Center (SDSC) personnel to immediately reviewed POD video where they observed a subject firing a handgun into the air. The subject subsequently entered a vehicle, which fled the scene. The SDSC personnel immediately notified responding units of the observation. Members of the 11th District observed the fleeing vehicle and stopped it on the 3800 block of West Congress Parkway at approximately 7:17 PM. During the traffic stop, a subject in that vehicle was identified as the person that was observed firing a handgun into the air. After consulting with Area North Detectives and approval of charges by the Assistant Cook County State's Attorney, Demontre Enos was charged with felony Unlawful Use of a Weapon by Felon and felony Reckless Discharge of a Firearm. Enos will appear today in Central Bond Court. No additional information is available at this time.
