### Man Charged with Attempt Murder of a Chicago Police Officer



**Offender:** Gerardo Jasso, 35  
7500 Block of N. Oakley Ave  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) Felony Count: Attempt-Murder-First Degree  
One (1) Felony Count: U UW-Weapon-Felon, Possess/Use Firearm  
One (1) Felony Count: PCS-Possession-Poss Amt Con Sub Except (A)(D)  
One (1) Felony Count Count: U UW-Agg U UW/Person/Vehicle/Prevs Conviction  
One (1) Misdemeanor Count: Drinking Alcohol on the Public Way

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave. – November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**Narrative:** Jasso was arrested on November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at approximately 3:21 p.m. in the 6200 Block of N. Campbell after officers attempted to speak with him once they observed him on the public way in possession of an open can of an alcoholic beverage. He fled on foot, pointed and fired a handgun at an officer who returned fire however, no one was struck. A handgun was recovered on scene and Jasso was taken into custody and charged accordingly.
