South Side Man Charged with Murder



Offender: James Dixon, 29
10300 Block of South Wallace
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) Felony Count: Murder-First Degree

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California Ave – November 29th, 2020

Narrative: Dixon was arrested on November 27th, 2020, 11:15 a.m., at Holy Cross Hospital after he was identified as the individual who stabbed a 52-year-old man multiple times in the upper body during an argument the same day in the 6800 Block of S. Talman at approximately 3:15 a.m. He and the victim were involved in a verbal altercation inside a residence that spilled onto the front porch and turned physical. The victim was transported to University of Chicago Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. Dixon was arrested at Holy Cross Hospital after he went to be treated for a small laceration to his neck and cuts to his finger. He was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No further details are available at this time.
