### South Side Man Charged with Murder in April Shooting



**Offender:** Jamelle Carraway, 22  
5800 block of S. May St  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count: Murder-First Degree  
One (1) felony count: Attempt-Murder-First Degree  
Issuance of Warrant

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – July 22, 2021

**Narrative:** Jamelle Carraway was arrested on July 21, 2021 at approximately 8:56 a.m. in the 5800 block of S. May St. He was identified as an offender in a shooting that occurred in the 6100 block of S. Marshfield (7<sup>th</sup> District) on April 5, 2021 at approximately 6:03 p.m. In that incident, two 20-year-old men were shot with one of them succumbing to their wounds after suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the torso. The second victim suffered a graze wound to the chest. Carraway was placed into custody without incident and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
