Offenders Charged with Murder of 40-Year-Old Female, Attempted Murder of Four Additional Victims

- **Narrative:** The above offenders were arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on August 23, 2023, in the 3100 block of N. Sayre Ave. in Chicago and the 6500 block of W. Montrose Ave., in Harwood Heights, Illinois, respectively. They were identified as the offenders who, on July 16, 2023, opened fire in the 4000 block of W. Washington Blvd. (11<sup>th</sup> District), fatally shooting a 40-year-old female. The offenders also shot and injured four additional victims, a 38-year-old female, a 38-year-old male, a 39-year-old male and a 42-yearold male. The offenders were placed into custody and charged accordingly No additional information is available at this time.
