# Community Alert

**Aggravated Vehicle Hijacking/

### **About the Crime:**

This alert gives notice to residents of the 014th District and 016th District of recent Aggravated Vehicle Hijackings and Armed Robberies. In these incidents the offenders arrived in a 4dr dark blue sedan. One or two offenders approached the victim. The offenders displayed a handgun and demanded the victim's personal belongings and money. In one incident the offenders also took the victim's vehicle. After robbing the victim the offenders fled the scene. In the 016th District incident, the victim was walking to their vehicle when one of the offenders pointed a black handgun at them and demanded the keys to their vehicle. The offenders then fled in the victim's vehicle.
