Man Charged in Attempted Vehicular Hijacking



Offender: Darrell Mitchell, 20
1400 block of S. Homan
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated – Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggr Discharge Firearm – Occupied Vehicle
One (1) felony count – Attempt – Robbery – Agg Robbery/Indicate Arm w/Fir

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – October 27, 2021

Narrative: Darrell Mitchell was arrested on October 26, 2021 at 2:06 a.m. in the 3800 block of W. Roosevelt. He was identified as the individual who, approximately 30 minutes earlier, attempted to take a vehicle by force from a 20-year-old man at a gas station in the 3800 block of W. Roosevelt (10th District). Mitchell then discharged a firearm in the victim's direction before fleeing. Responding officers were investigating when the offender returned to the scene at which time he was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly.
