Juvenile Charged with Vehicular Hijacking



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

Charge: One (1) felony count: Vehicular Hijacking
One (1) misdemeanor count: Battery-Make Physical Contact

Court: Juvenile Court – 1100 S. Hamilton - February 28, 2021

Narrative: A 17-year-old male was arrested on February 27, 2021, at approximately 5:46 p.m., in the 800 block of W. Fulton Market and charged with a vehicular hijacking that occurred minutes earlier in the 900 block of W. Randolph (12th District). A 28-year-old man had parked his vehicle on the street to make a food delivery when he observed the offender enter his car. The victim attempted to open the driver's side door at which point he was kicked and pushed out of the vehicle by the offender after being dragged a short distance. While driving, the offender then struck another vehicle that was attempting to park. After a brief foot pursuit, responding officers placed him into custody. The victim declined medical attention and the offender was charged accordingly.
