019th, 014th, 017th, 016th & 025th Districts

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to Auto Repair Businesses residing in the 014th and 019th Districts of recently reported robbery and multiple burglaries. In these incidents, offender(s) gain entry by throwing a brick or large stone to break glass doors or window. In one incident a vehicle was used to ram garage overhead door to make entry. Once inside vehicles, vehicle keys and money from registers are taken. These incidents have occurred during the early morning hours in the general geographical locations listed below:

- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating detectives.
