Offender Charged with Thirty-Two Felonies, Including Multiple Counts of Attempted Murder & Aggravated Battery



Offender: William Groves, 48
8100 block of S. Bishop Ave., Chicago, Illinois

Charges: Fifteen (15) felony counts – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
Fifteen (15) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated UUW - Weapon- Felon, Possess/Use Firearm
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Discharge Firearm - Occupied Building

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – October 31, 2023

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on October 29, 2023, at approximately 1:09 a.m., in the 4000 block of W. 14th St. He was positively identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, fired shots into a building in the 1200 block of S. Pulaski (10th District), causing injuries to fifteen (15) adult victims. The offender was quickly placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly.
