### **Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts, Including Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking and Armed Robbery**



**Offender:** Edmund Singleton, 32  
5200 block of S. Indiana Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Received/Possess/Sell Stolen Vehicle  
One (1) felony count – UUA - Weapon - Felon, Posses/Use Firearm  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Possess Cannabis/>30-100 Gram/1<sup>st</sup>

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – April 15, 2023

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on April 13, 2023, in the 800 block of E. 90<sup>th</sup> Pl. He was identified as one of the offenders who took a vehicle at gunpoint from a 43-year-old male on November 3, 2022, at approximately 6:59 p.m., in the 10000 block of S. Michigan (5<sup>th</sup> District). He is also charged with the attempted vehicular hijacking and armed robbery that occurred hours later, on November 3, 2022, in the 3100 block of S. Michigan (2<sup>nd</sup> District), and in connection to a stolen vehicle on November 3, 2023, from the 9400 block of S. Woodlawn (4<sup>th</sup> District).
